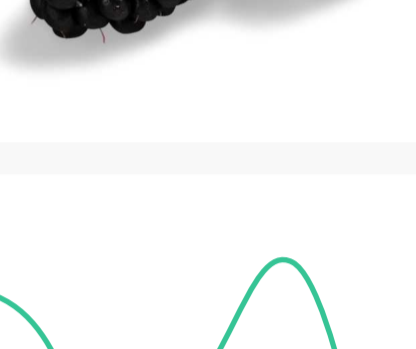
With summer finally here, we're thrilled to see an influx of great **quality seasonal fruits and vegetables**.

Keep up with our **market updates** to stay informed on all important changes in the produce world and how they affect the price, quality and supply of our products.

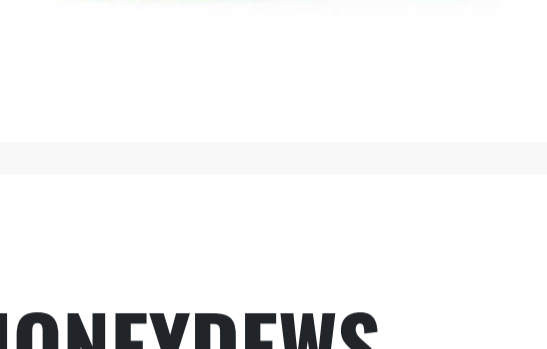

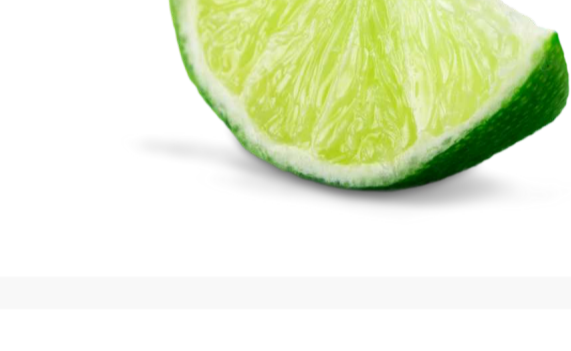

Mexico season has wrapped up, but production in Florida and Georgia is now in full swing.

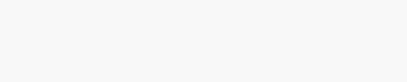
Prices are expected to decrease.
