Mexico and offshore growers are managing late-season harvests. Heat, wind, and insect pressure continue to affect yields for citrus and lettuce. East Coast vegetable production is ramping up, helping to ease prices on green beans, cucumbers, and squash. Overall quality is strong, but small sizing, sporadic defects, and regional gaps mean smart substitutions and forward planning remain key.




