


## September MARKET UPDATES Early September brings shifting markets as California transitions into late-season production. September also sees market shifts due to California's late-season crops


overlapping with supply filling from Mexico and Peru. Warm

Strawberries are increasing in price as California harvests wind down, blueberries are becoming scarcer, and blackberries remain high. New-crop apples and pears are showing excellent quality with strong
